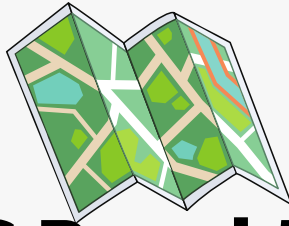

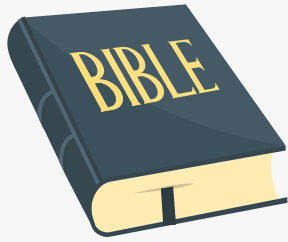

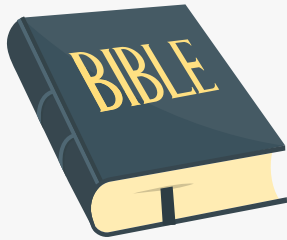

2	Jan 31	<p>Weekly Verse: Colossians 1:16-17 Taught last week - recite this week. For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him. And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together.</p> <p>Bonus Verse: Romans 8:1-2 Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death.</p>
3	Feb 7	<p>Weekly Verse: Galatians 5:22-23 Taught last week - recite this week. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.</p> <p>Bonus Verse: Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.</p>

my salvation comes from him.

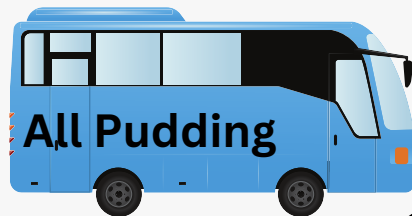
Truly he is my rock and my salvation;

The Bible says we are fearfully and wonderfully made. That means that God did such an amazing job on creating us that it is more than our brains can understand.

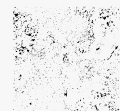
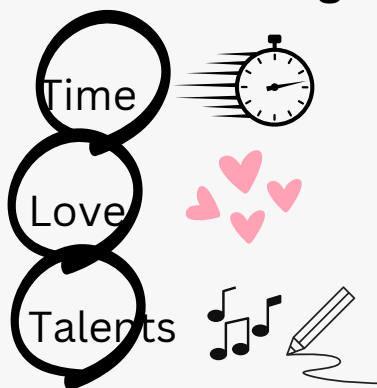
God made us to be able to praise, worship and serve Him.

trying to obey God in their own strength.



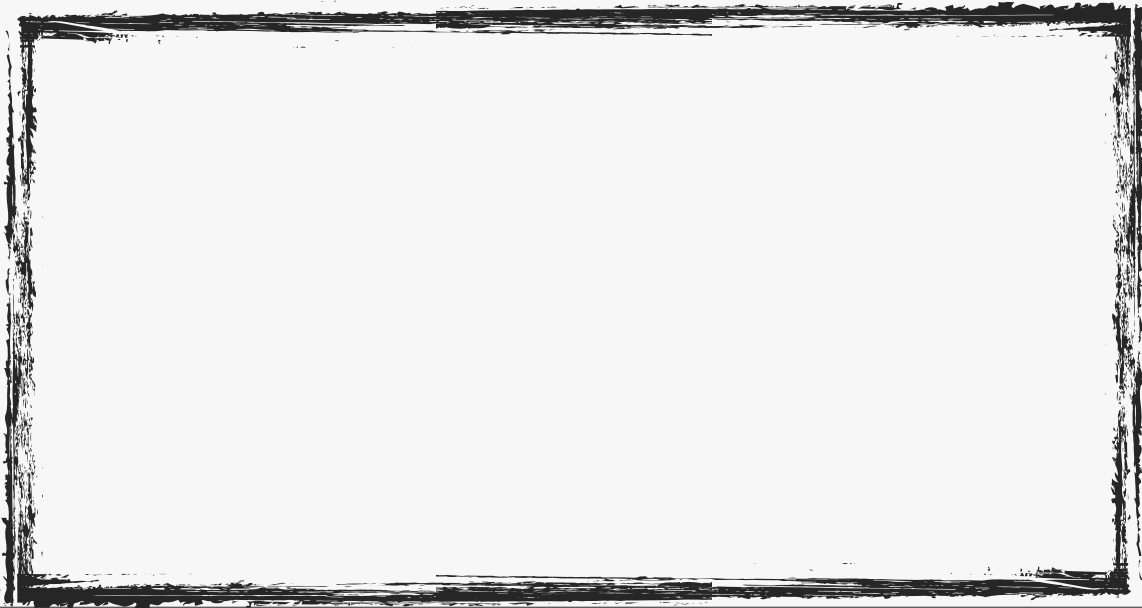

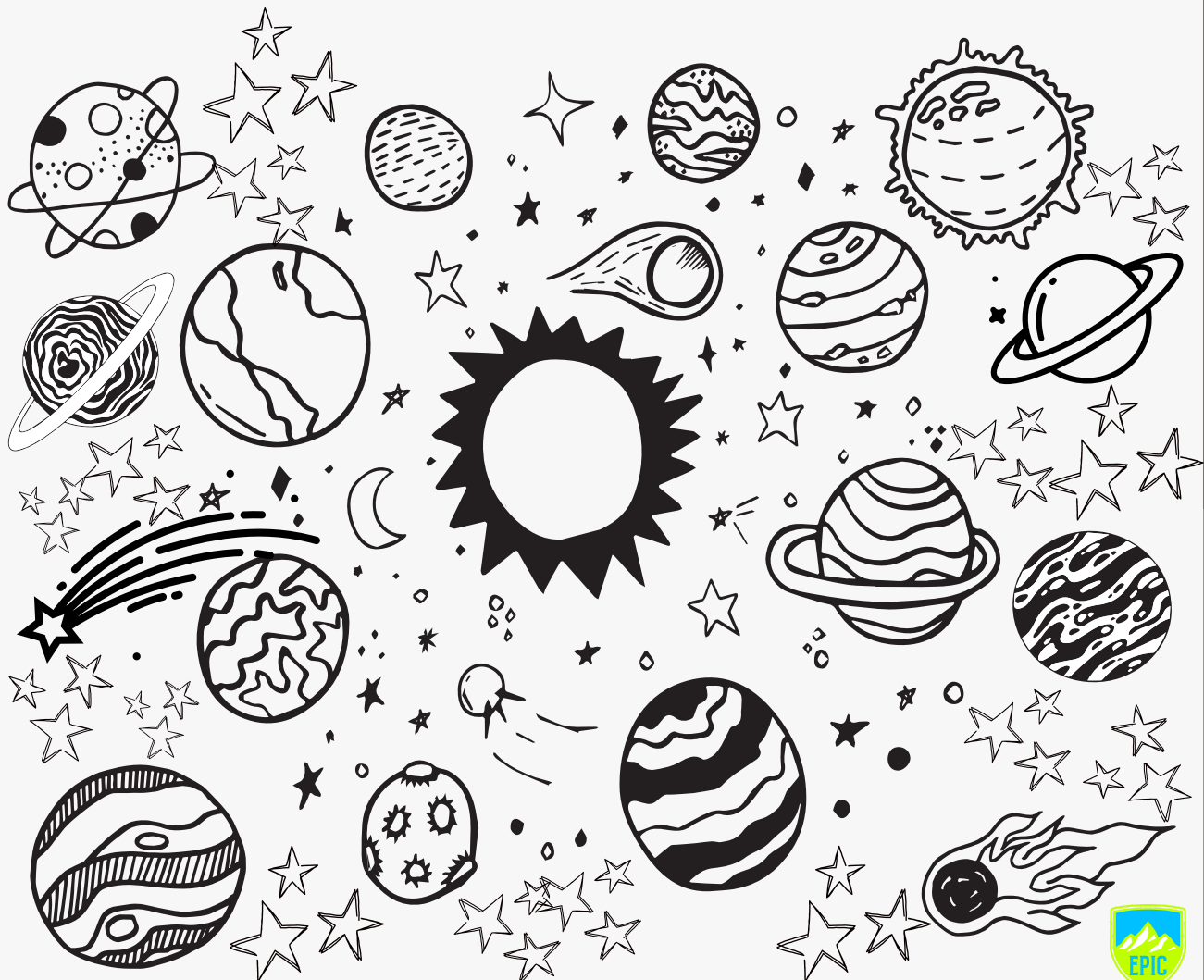

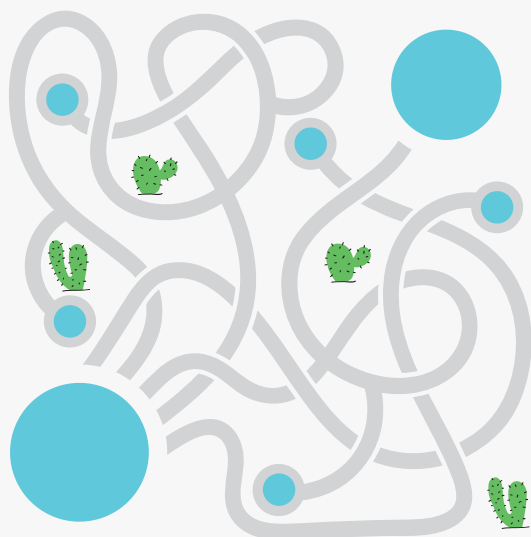
